IPM Council were sorry to learn of the recent death of Ian Jones, Emeritus Professor of Pharmacy Practice at the University of Portsmouth and, a man who for many years was the face of IPMI. He joined the Institute in 1966 as a lecturer at the then Sunderland Polytechnic and joined Council in 1971 when he was a Senior Lecturer at the University of Bradford becoming Chairman in 1975-6 and again in 1994, he took on the role Secretary in 1995-6 and was President 1997 - 2005 whilst Professor of Pharmacy Practice at Portsmouth University, becoming Honorary Life Vice President 2006 when he retired.
